

13. Mentoring Undergraduate Research in Different College/University Settings

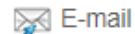
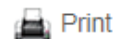
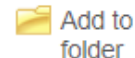

Abstract: One innovative strategy for increasing undergraduate students' engagement in research. Mentoring is one of the few opportunities that afford extended face-to-face and close interactions with faculty. However, mentoring undergraduate students in doing research is not the same at different types of colleges and universities. This paper gives insights into how undergraduate students are being mentored in doing research in different **university/college** settings, namely a premier **university (University of Buffalo)**, a public senior college (**York College**) and a private **university (Pace University)**. The main goal is to discuss the undergraduate research structure at the four institutions. I will discuss the advantages and disadvantages of each setting, emphasizing research with emphasis at **Pace University**. 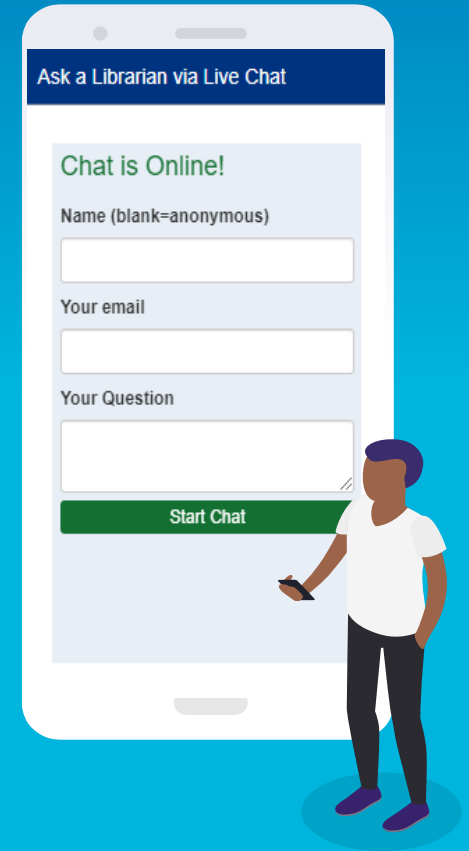
