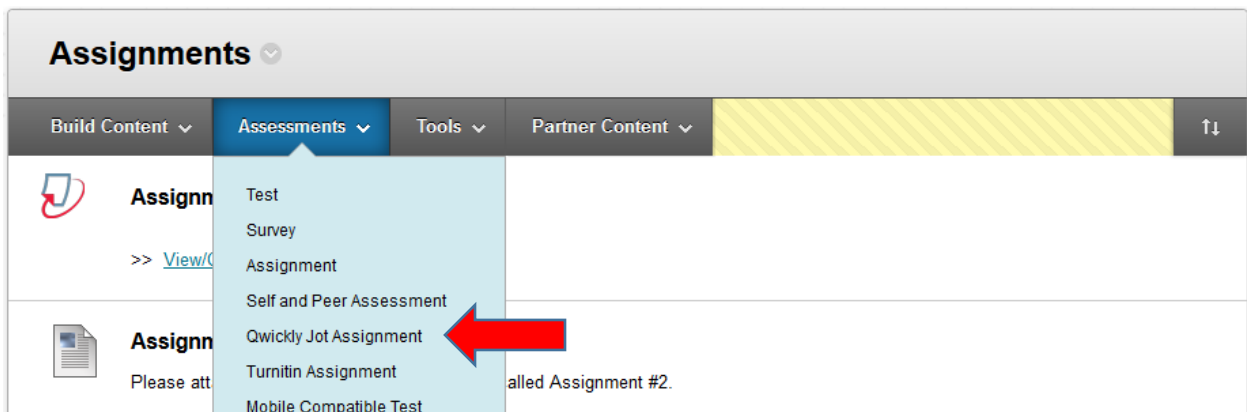

CREATING A QWICKLY JOT ASSIGNMENT ON BLACKBOARD

Assignments on Blackboard can be made with Qwickly Jot. This tool allows you to create assignments with diagrams, maps, charts and more for students to mark on.

1. Under “Assignments” in Blackboard, move your mouse over “Assessments”, and click on “Qwickly Jot Assignment”.



2. Give your assignment a name and add the assignment instructions.

Qwickly Jot Assignment

Assignments are a form of assessment that adds a column to the Grade Center. Use the Grade Center to assign grades and give feedback to each student. This Assignment type allows an interactive canvas for students to write on for their submission.

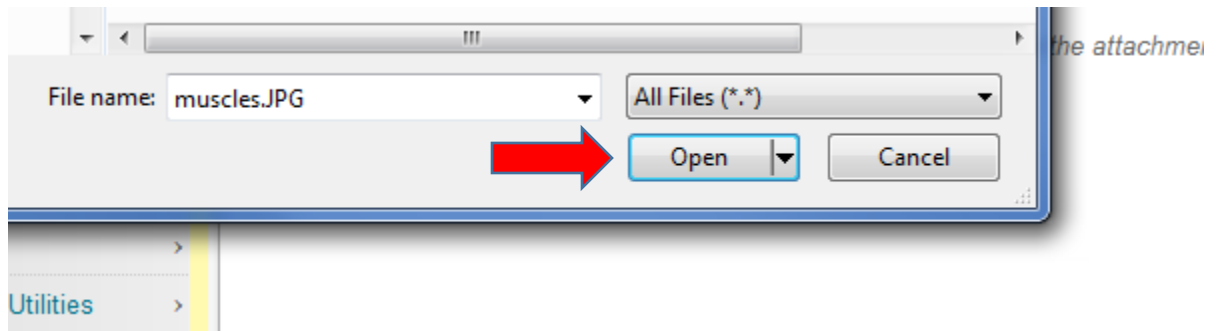
