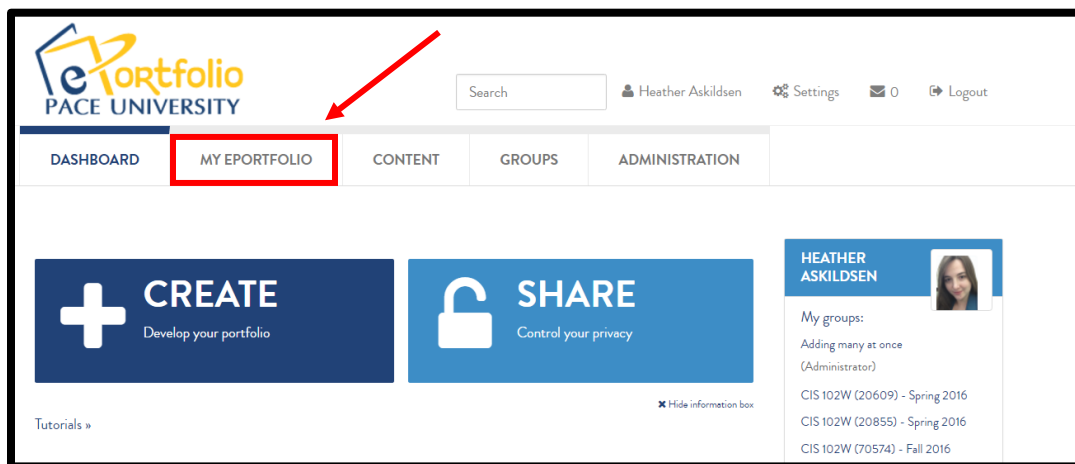

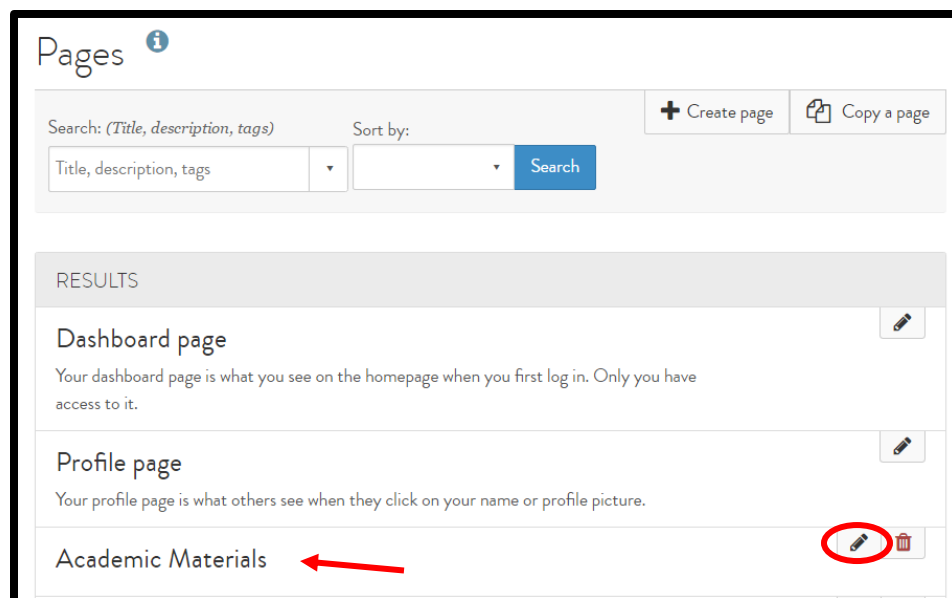
EMBEDDING STORIFY IN EPORTFOLIO

This tutorial will show you how to embed a Storify project in your ePortfolio.

1. After **logging into** ePortfolio, go to the **My ePortfolio** tab.

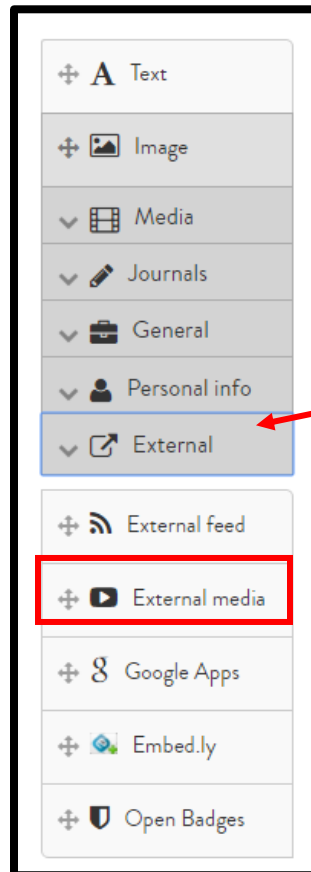


2. Under **Pages**, choose the page you want to display your Storify on, and select the **grey pencil icon** next to the desired page.

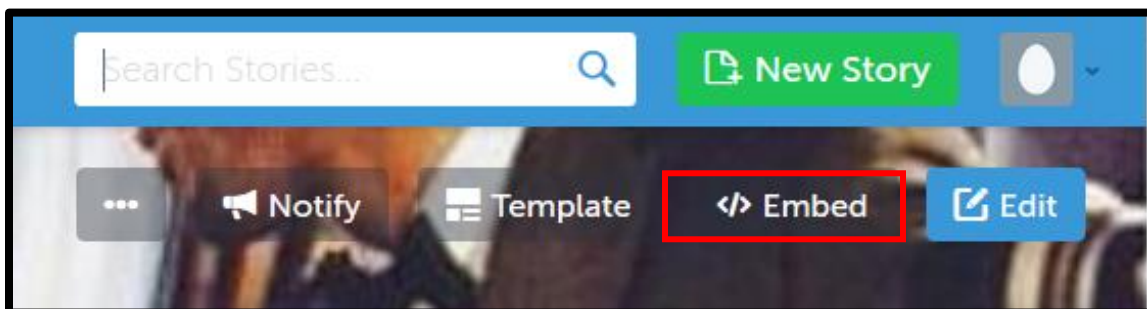

3. Click on **External** in the toolbar. Select **External media** and drag it to your page.

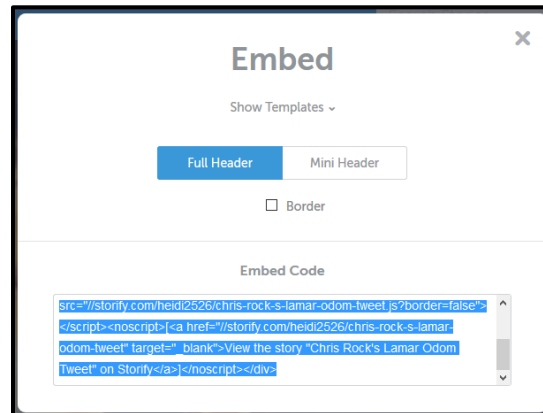


4. In another tab, log into your **Storfy** account and click **View** on the story you wish to display. In the top right corner, you'll see a button that says **Embed**.

5. Click this and **copy** the embed code.
