

Dr. Ashley Jenkins works as a Licensed Forensic Psychologist for the United States Department of Justice; specifically, the Federal Bureau of Prisons. She recently transferred from the Metropolitan Correctional Center in New York City to the Metropolitan Detention Center in Brooklyn, New York.
