## Certificate of Completion / Research and Citation Workshop

This requirement applies to students who matriculated beginning with fall 2013:

As part of the Upper-Level Writing Requirement, all students must complete a Research and Citation Workshop with the Law School's Reference Librarians some time during the second, third, or fourth year of Law School.

Students may satisfy this requirement in the following ways:

- 1. Completion of the Advanced Legal Research course (3 credits).
- 2. Completion of an Advanced Research Skills course (2 credits).
- 3. Courses, e.g. seminars, Advanced Appellate Advocacy, or Federal Judicial Honors, taken to fulfill the Upper-Level Writing Requirement that incorporate a Research and Citation Workshop.
- 4. For students who are doing a guided research project or law review note to meet the upper-level writing requirement, attendance at one of the Research and Citation workshops presented by the Reference Librarians several times during the fall and spring semesters.
- 5. Attending research assistant training presented by one of the Reference Librarians.

The following do NOT satisfy this requirement

- 1. 1L legal skills.
- 2. Short presentations (15-30 minutes) offered in class by the Reference Librarians.
- 3. Law review training that does not include a Research and Citation workshop presented by the Reference Librarians. All students must attach this Certificate of Completion, signed by a Reference Librarian, to the Faculty Authorization for
