### • Treasury/Fundraising/Budget

- o Board Fund Balance: \$14,003.28
- o Thank you to Members who have contributed this year, and those who have not please contribute so that we can plan spending for the remainder of the year
- Law Leadership spending discussion
  - Last year table of 10 was purchased at cost by Board, it was very beneficial to have Board presence at the event, demonstrating cohesiveness and benefit of Board

IV. New Business Alumni Board

- Kayla proposed contributing to school's networking event on February 13, 2025, held annually for past few years to connect students with private sector employers
- Event has been successful, 70-80 participants last year, Raymond and Cassia attended and shared that it was a positive experience
- Event costs around \$1,500, funds historically came from Center for Career and Professional Development's (CCPD) budget, but that budget is low especially after CCPD absorbed PILC (Public Interest Law Center)
- Discussion of why catered cost is so high, potential for alternatives to catering by Chartwell (including potluck with alumni bringing food, etc.), and potential for holding event off-campus, with Kayla indicating that CCPD does not want to hold event at other than the law school because of concerns about appearance of sponsorship of a particular potential employer
- Decision tabled for now
