Tuan Malinowski (Noise)

Tuan Malinowski (they/them) is a New York—based director and choreographer, reclaiming the landscape of the American musical theatre. Malinowski's choreographic work includes Cabaret (Northern Stage), Pippin (Weathervane Theatre), and productions at Texas State University, Ithaca College, Viterbo University and the University of Alabama at Birmingham. They have choreographed for celebrated New York—events, like Jay Armstrong Johnson's I Put A Spell On You and Leg Up On Life's Night of Life. Malinowski is an alum of New York Theatre Barn's Choreography Lab, where they were mentored by Emmy-winning, Tony-nominated choreographer

Joshua Bergasse. Malinowski has been an associate/assistant on off-Broadway and regional productions such as Chay Yew's praised reexamination of South Pacific (Goodspeed Musicals), the world premiere of Game On (Pittsburgh CLO) and The Perfect Game (Theatre Row). They were also the observer for New York City Center's acclaimed Encores! production of The Light in the Piazza. BFA, Ithaca College. Associate Member, SDC. Katie Walker (For My Love!)

Katie Walker attended the University of North Carolina School of the Arts from 8th grade through high school graduation with a major in Ballet. She spent her summers training at American Ballet Theater, Boston Ballet, Houston Ballet and Kaatsbaan Ballet. Upon graduation, Katie joined Cedar Lake Contemporary Ballet in NYC as an artist. In 2008, Katie became a Radio City Rockette and in her 15 years as a Rockette, has held the role of assistant dance captain, swing, dance captain and assistant choreographer. As a Rockette, Katie performed at The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade, The Rockefeller Center Tree Lighting, America's Got Talent, The Annual White House Christmas Party and The Today Show. In 2015 and 2016, Katie helped create and stage the NY Spring Spectacular and the NY Spectacular alongside Warren Carlyle and Mia Michaels. As an assistant choreographer, Katie helped direct and choreograph for the Tony Awards, MTV Video Music Awards, USO Partnership Performances, America's Got Talent, The Kacey Musgraves Christmas Special and a Hallmark Channel Movie "A Holiday Spectacular". She has had the honor to serve as co-rehearsal director and assistant to Linda Haberman for The Verdon Fosse Legacy's "Sweet Gwen Suite" on performances at the Hudson Valley Dance Festival, Red Bucket Follies and Hubbard Street Dance Chicago. Katie founded Elevate Ballet in 2022, a company that focuses on ballet training for aspiring Rockettes, jazz, Broadway and musical theater dancers. She is the cofounder of The Precision Dance Collective which hosts monthly workshops and annual performances with a focus on precision dance training. Katie is currently a choreographer in New York City. Her work was recently performed for Jazz Choreography Enterprises Spring Showcase, Broadway Dance Center CTP and the Julia Kane Dance Collective. When not teaching at Broadway Dance Center or Steps On Broadway, she can be found running around New Jersey with her 3 little kids.

Marinda Davis (Have Mercy)

Touring with conventions from a young age, Marinda worked as an assistant to Gus Giordano, Frank Hatchett, Ray Leeper, Dennis Caspary & Lisa Allain. She graduated from Marymount Manhattan College while simultaneously training at BDC with her mentor, Sheila Barker. Marinda danced professionally with Sting, 98 Degrees & was a founding/principal dancer for Anthony Morigerato's, AMDP, NY. In 2010, Dance.comrecognized her as a Top 10 Young Choreographer. Known as an inspiring, life changing educator & mentor, Marinda inspires countless dancers across the world. She's on faculty at BDC, Peridance, in 10 sive, Art of Movement, Power Pak, Genesis & WILD. She is the Artistic Director of marInspired; the storytellers, founded in 2009. In 2012, marInspired's 1st full length show, "Breakable" premiered & that same year, Marinda received her 1st Capezio ACE Award nom, her 2nd in 2015; the latter, receiving 2nd place & funding for "UNbreakable". It previewed at Dancerpalooza & premiered at the El Portal in LA in 2016. In 2017, Marinda self produced "UNbreakable" at NY's Symphony Space, & in 2019 at the SCERA Theatre in Utah. In 2017, Marinda choreographed a piece for the DWTS Season 25 finale starring Julianne Hough. Marinda's powerful story was the subject of the Emmy Honored docuseries My Last Days on the CW in 2018. That summer, marInspired was featured on Szn 2 of NBC's World of Dance. Marinda was the Exec Choreographer for Season 10 of Comedy Central's Tosh.0 &

Abbvie's "Speak Endo" campaign where she choreographed PSA's starring Julianne Hough. In 2019, Marinda was commissioned to set a new work on Giordano Chicago. "Flickers" premiered at The Harris & was reviewed as a "masterpiece" & her movement "a genre unto itself." In 2020, Marinda choreographed the film, "Clouds" for Disney+ & in 2021, an art docufilm, "Steadfast." She also appeared as a celebrity judge on Siwas Dance Pop Revolution on E!
