

Pace University Off Campus Disruptive Behavior Sanctioning Guidelines

Conduct on or off campus in a manner the University determines reflects adversely on the good name and reputation of the University is prohibited	\$100 Fine Probation [min 3 months] Educational Sanctions Community Service Parental/Coach notification Alcohol transport will result in Immediate Mandatory referral for Assessment by AOD Counselor	\$200 Fine Minimum of 4 Weekend Suspension from the Residence Halls Assessment by AOD Counselor Probation [min 6 months] Educational Sanction Community Service Parental/Coach notification
Violence or Misuse of Community Property Violation	1 st Offense (Dean for Students, Assistant Dean for students, or their designee)	2 nd Offense (Dean for Students, Assistant Dean for Students, or their designee)
Deliberate actions that cause, or might reasonably be expected to cause, injury, either physical or mental, to any member of the University community or surrounding community are prohibited. Such actions may include, for example, violence or threats of violence. Theft, willful destruction or damage to or misuse of any University property or property owned by any member of the university community or surrounding community is prohibited. Impacted the community: Conduct on or off campus in a manner the University determines reflects adversely on the good name and reputation of the University is prohibited	\$200 Fine Restitution (if applicable) Probation Educational Sanction Community Service Suspension from Housing/University (If applicable) Parental/Coach notification	\$300 Fine Restitution (if applicable) Suspension from the Residence Halls and/or University for not less than one year Probation Educational Sanction Community Svc. Hours Parental/Coach notification

The weekend suspension begins at 6:00 PM on Friday and ends at 6:00 PM on Sunday. The suspension is a formal separation **from all Pace University Residence Halls** and may include other Pace sponsored activities and academics as approved by the Dean for Students or designee.

Failure to comply or complete any of the above noted sanction(s) will result in further judicial action. Each judicial hearing will be based on individual merit. The Hearing officer will consider mitigating and/or aggravating circumstances and reserves the right to decrease/increase any sanctions noted above.
